What is EPR

EPR stands for **Extended Producer Responsibility**. It makes producers, like retailers, manufacturers and restaurants that supply packaging and paper to households, responsible for managing materials after people use them. This can include partial or full financial and operational responsibility.

Current EPR Model:

75%

Shared Responsibility

- Producers responsible for up to **75%** of the costs.
- Local governments manage own programs.

Future EPR Model:

100%

Managed by Producers

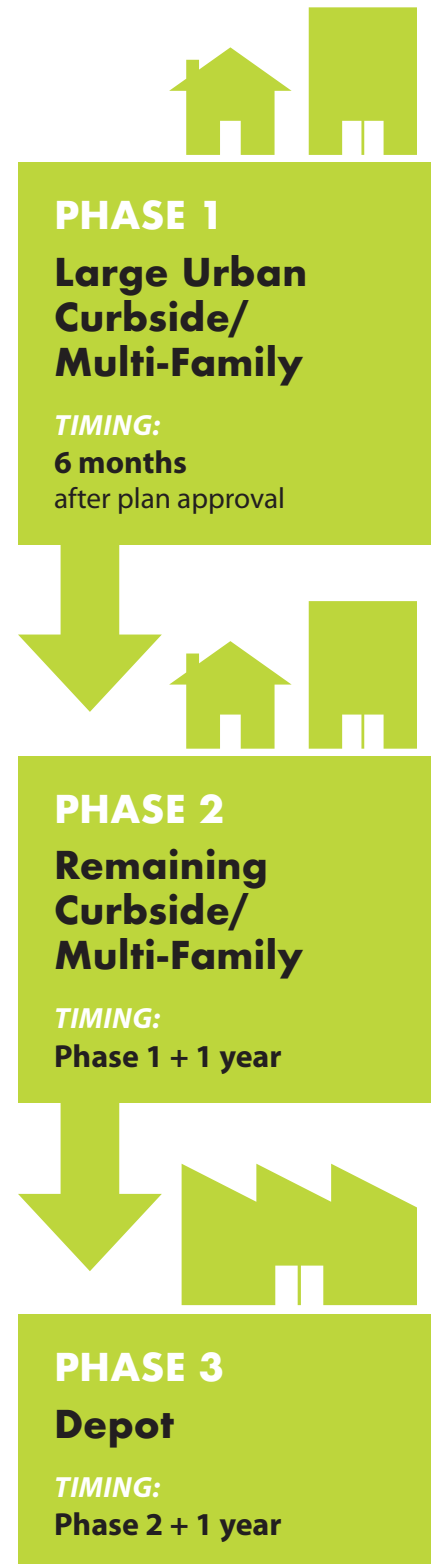
- Producers assume operational and financial responsibility for collecting and recycling household packaging and paper products.
- Local governments and private collection contractors partner with MMSW for collection and MMSW ensures material is responsibly recycled.
